Regular rail services connect to Newquay from most of the country. Newquay's St Mawgan airport, with its regular scheduled services is only a fifteen minute drive away.

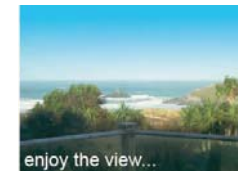
